Albariño is a dry white wine produced from a wine grape variety that is best known in the Iberian Peninsula countries of Spain and Portugal. Its popularity in California is on the rise with approximately 347 acres planted in 2017. The first known California planting was in 1992. This white wine grape generally produces a light colored, aromatic and high acid light to medium bodied wine that often exhibits ripe citrus and stone fruit flavors.

Lodi Overview - Tour of Albariño




